One of the most common error is the failure to use quotation marks or using quotation marks incorrectly. Rather than using " or ' symbols, you must use " and ' symbols for footnotes and endnotes. These two pairs of symbols are not interchangeable, so make sure you're using the correct ones. Another mistake many make is not putting a proper title on a source. This means you must include a work's last name and first initial, as well as the year it was published. Something like "The Origins of Western Civilisation In Ancient Egypt by Howard Williams" would be incorrect because the date may be different from the one you see. The most common thing that can go wrong with your documents, however, is using words from someone else's document not as they were used in their own but as they were used in their original work. This is known as paraphrasing someone else's words or ideas and it happens a lot on college text reports or essays. There are a lot of ways to avoid these common errors in your documents. First, make sure you put in all the information in the proper order. Second, make sure you cite or reference all your work properly and in a way that is easy to find. Lastly, read over what you have written from start to finish and look for anything that might be confusing or lose meaning from being taken out of context.
